

## 2024 Council Elections

The next Council elections are due to be held 14 September 2024 with the polling venue being the Hay War Memorial Hall. It is anticipated that pre-polling will be arranged for Hay for the week 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> September. Candidate nominations run from 5<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> August. Staff are also working with the NSW Electoral Commission and LGNSW on options to conduct Councillors Information Sessions, to help prospective candidates understand the roles and expectations of being a councillor. These will range from website links to seminars. It is anticipated that staff will hold candidate information sessions in person in July. Staff are only too willing to help prospective candidates understand the election process and the obligations required during an election and once elected as a councillor.

Once the elected council is determined, all councillors will be required to undertake a 'Councillor Induction', as well as several training sessions including 'Code of Conduct' and 'Code of Meeting Practice'. These will be both before and after the first meeting of the new Council.

Due to postal votes being received for up to 13 days after election day, councils' elections are not likely to be declared before 30 September 2024, with the declaration most likely be around the 2nd or 3rd October 2024. Councils that elect their mayor must hold a mayoral election within 3 weeks of the declaration of the ordinary election and are required to schedule a meeting for this purpose within 3 weeks of the declaration of the election. Accordingly, Council must hold its first meeting of the new Council on Tuesday 22nd October 2024.

## Changes to Waste Collections

### 3 Bin Kerbside Collection

Council has commenced distribution of bins for the new 3 bin kerbside collection that will start from the 1st July 2024. All residences will receive

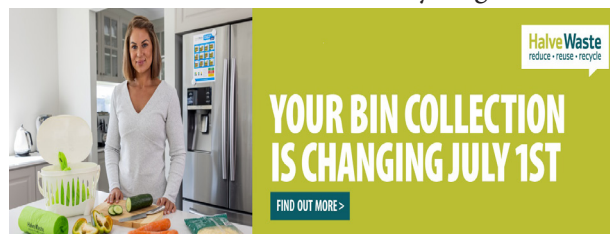
- \* 240 ltr **Yellow** lidded bin
- \* 240 ltr **Green** lidded bin
- \* 240 ltr **Red** lidded bin
- \* Kitchen caddy
- \* Roll of kitchen caddy liners
- \* Introductory pack including collection calendar.

When delivered, your kitchen caddy, liners and inductory pack will be placed inside your green lidded bin. Up to 25th June, keep using your current bin for collection, *After 25th June you can start using your new bins, ready for pick up from 1st July.*

### Waste Transfer Station - Proposed Introduction of Tip Fees

It is proposed to charge tip fees at the waste transfer station for certain waste materials as of 1st July 2024. It is also proposed that the fees will be cashless only (eftpos tap & go) at the facility. The tip fees are planned as part of the way that waste management is being administered and managed, to reduce the volume going to landfill and conserve the limited space at the facility. Residents will still be able to dispose of their recyclables and materials into the CRC shed for free. For a full list of Waste Management Fees please view the draft 2024/25 Fees and Charges on Council's website which are scheduled to be adopted at the June 2024 Ordinary meeting of Council.

Once adopted, the fees will be displayed on Council's website under 'Waste & Recycling'.
