John Houston Memorial Swimming Pool Replacement

Council at its meeting 26th November 2024 resolved to award Contracts to ELM Aquatics to undertake the replacement of the John Houston Memorial Swimming Pools.

The Hay community will be able to enjoy brand new, state of the art, swimming pools for the 2025-25 swimming season. Works are due to commence late February/early March and hope to be completed by late November 2025.



This will mean the community will have shorter pool opening seasons for both this year and next. Further details will be provided in due course.

Kerbside Collection Update!! Very Important!

Commencing January the 13th 2025, occasionally you may find a sticker on one of your kerbside bins. A green 'NON COLLECTION NOTICE' sticker means the collection truck driver was not able to empty your bin.

There are a few reasons why this may happen: -

- Bin facing the wrong way
- Not a Council approved bin
- Bin too heavy (must not exceed 80kg)
 - Bin overfull
- Bin is contaminated this could be with plastic bags, general garbage, soil etc

Council staff will leave a sticker on your bin telling you why it has not been picked up.

When the wrong items (such as plastic bags) are placed in your FOGO bin, this results in contamination, and this can mean a whole load of FOGO (food and garden organics) may be sent to landfill.

We want to make sure that Hay's recycling can be processed correctly and used to make new products. That's why if your bin is contaminated you will need to address the issue identified on the sticker before Councils next week's collection.
